Maude has completed the Master Class in Attachment Focused Psychotherapy and Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy through Dr. Art Becker Weidman and has also completed the 5-day introduction course of Dr. Daniel Hughes. She serves on the Board for ATTACH for the next 3 years. She designs her own live courses with regards to emotional processing and executive functioning. She is well known for her experience and work with children who carry a diagnosis on the Autism Spectrum, Attachment, Sensory Processing Disorder, and Dyslexia/ Learning Disabilities. Maude is an international speaker and mentor to many professionals internationally. She has co-authored the book, *The Listening Journey*, with Françoise Nicoloff, and her second book, *Our Greatest Allies*, is now available on Amazon.com. Her basic philosophy is that all children can learn, and that therapists are instrumental in finding out the "key" to each child. She enjoys empowering therapists to do just that!
